

#### SEARCH PAGE

- Use *keyword anywhere* for searching in all categories simultaneously—title, uniform title, author, etc. Using complete words is unnecessary: *eras* will show results for *erasmus*, *Erasmum*, *erased*, *litteras*, and all other words containing the sequence *eras*.
- Use *title* for searching an edition if you know exact words on its title page.
- Use *uniform title* for searching an edition if you do not know any exact words on its title page.
- Use *uniform title* for searching editions of a work irrespective of the exact words on any title page. For example, *Moriae encomium* will show all results for *Moriae encomium* as well as *Laus stultitiae*, *Praise of Folly*, *Eloge de la Folie*, *Lof der Zotheid*, etc. Please note that the uniform titles themselves are in Latin.
- Use *erasmus online number* if you know the record number of a specific edition in Erasmus Online. These numbers are fixed and can safely be used for long-term reference.
- Use the *index* next to each search box for browsing the choices at your disposal for your chosen search category. Please note that some search categories have no index available (e.g. *title* and *ordo*).
- Use *ordo* for searching editions along the categories (*ordines*) by which Erasmus himself classified his books. This classification is used in all three editions of Erasmus's collected works (Basel 1538–1540; Leiden 1703–1706, Amsterdam 1969–).
- Check *show facsimiles only* for searching editions fully digitized in EOL.

#### SEARCH RESULTS PAGE

Click the title to go to the bibliographical record of the edition (*Description*). The results are presented chronologically, starting with any undated editions.

#### DETAIL PAGE

- Click *Title page* to see an image of the title page.
- Click *Facsimile* to see the entire text of the edition. You need the free DjVu plug-in to see the text.
- Click *References* to see copies of additional bibliographical sources (catalogue cards, reference works).
